Benefits of PRP Therapy:

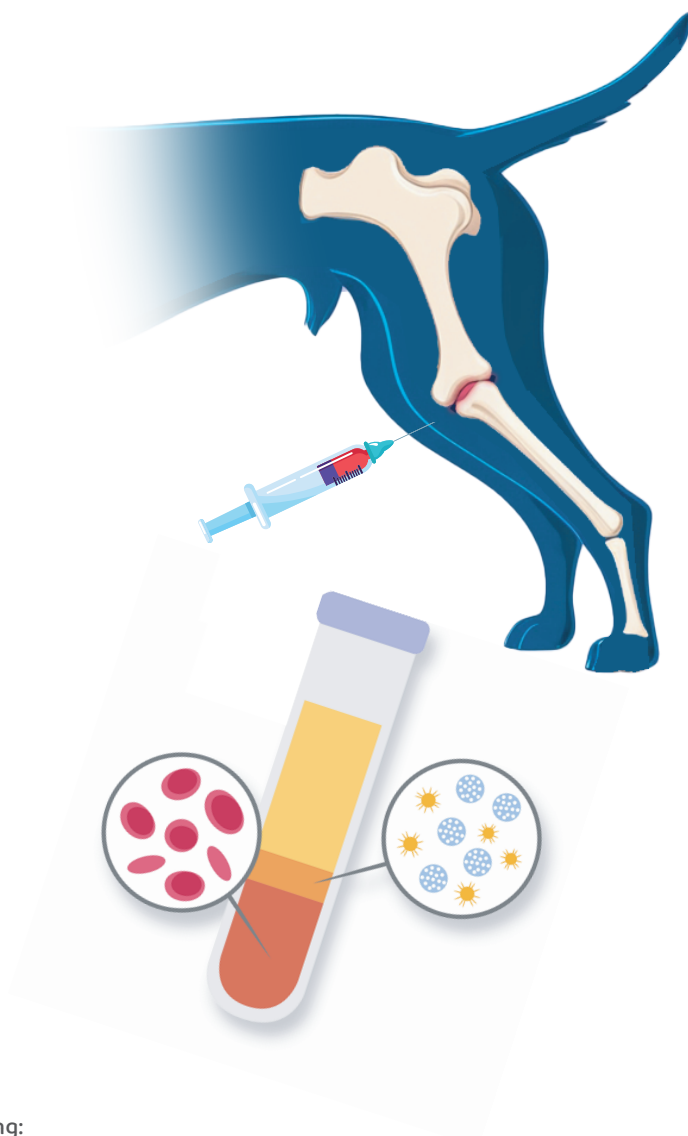
